Since 1959, the Australian Petroleum Production and Exploration Association Limited (APPEA) has been the peak national body representing the collective interests of the upstream oil and gas exploration and production industry.

APPEA's full member companies explore for and produce Australia's oil and gas resources. These companies currently account for an estimated 98 per cent of the nation's petroleum production.

In addition, APPEA represents many associate member companies that provide a wide range of goods and services to industry.

APPEA works with the Australian, state and territory governments to ensure that the regulatory and commercial framework promotes investment and maximises the return to the Australian community from finding and developing the nation's oil and gas resources.

APPEA aims to secure conditions that help its member companies operate safely, sustainably and profitably. APPEA also works to increase community and government understanding of the upstream petroleum industry by publishing information about its activities and economic importance to the nation.

Regular APPEA forums facilitate the exchange of ideas and help develop the industry's policy positions.

There are three types of APPEA membership:

- full member
- associate member
- honorary life member.

A full member of APPEA must be:

- the holder of a registered tenement (or of any lawful interest in such a tenement to explore for and/or to produce petroleum in Australia)
- expending or lawfully obliged to expend money in the exploration for and/or production of petroleum in Australia
- or
- suitable for admission having regard to the actual or potential participation in and/or contribution to the industry.

The full membership categories are based on the company's mix of total predicted boe production, size and scope of interest.



Participate in APPEA policy committees

Full members of APPEA are eligible to participate on APPEA's policy committees.

These committees are critical in developing industry positions on key policy issues that may affect the industry. The committee work directly informs APPEA's advocacy to governments and policy makers.

The policy committees also provide an invaluable networking forum for the industry to exchange ideas and expertise, directly benefitting member companies and their personnel.

Full members of APPEA have ready access to a specialist policy team with expertise on federal and state-based policy matters and important operational areas that affect the industry, including:

- tax and commercial matters
- energy markets
- greenhouse policies
- environmental and regulatory policies
- exploration and access policies
- safety policies and initiatives.

Notification and analysis of policy and regulatory announcements APPEA's full member-only *Information Bulletins* provide timely advice and analysis of policy and regulatory announcements that may affect the industry.

APPEA members also receive alerts and preventative advice on critical workplace safety issues.

Regular updates on major industry issues, progress on APPEA's advocacy work and industry news is also provided in the *APPEA Member's Report*, *Flowline* and other email newsletters, and the annual report.



Top level federal, state and territory access and representation	 APPEA advocates on behalf of the industry directly to ministers and policy makers. The association works towards the development and implementation of policy and regulatory settings that encourage industry growth, ensure the provision of appropriate regulation and take full account of critical industry issues. It has offices with a state director in Queensland, Western Australia and the Northern Territory. APPEA also represents its members on a range of federal, state and territory ministerial reference groups and working parties. These groups provide advice on the content and impact of major policy developments. 				
Consideration for a position on the APPEA Board	Full members of APPEA are eligible to nominate for a position on the APPEA Board, the body that considers issues significant to the industry and the association's advocacy to ministers and their departments. The APPEA Board comprises a national chairman and 15 other board members.				
Member-only forums and networking events	APPEA associate members can attend member-only forums organised by the association throughout the year, including the annual general meeting. Member-only forums, such as the Members' Lunch, are also held as part of the annual APPEA Conference and Exhibition. The association's Tax and Commercial Conference, a key biennial forum addressing commercial issues affecting the petroleum exploration and production industry, is another member-only event.
