

THE REG SPRIGG GOLD MEDAL: CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The Reg Sprigg Gold Medal, formerly the APEA Gold Medal, is awarded by the APPEA Board in recognition of an individual's outstanding service in promoting the objectives of the Australian oil and gas exploration and production industry.

The medal was introduced in 1989 and renamed the Reg Sprigg Medal in 1995 to commemorate the outstanding service that Dr Reginald Sprigg AO (1919-1994) provided to the petroleum industry through his own work and as the founding Chairman of APPEA.

This award is well recognised within the oil and gas industry and if you are aware of a person with the appropriate credentials, we would be very pleased to receive your nomination in accordance with the following:

Eligibility:

Candidates may be considered eligible for their outstanding service towards promoting the objectives of the industry through highly valued contributions in and to the Australian oil and gas industry or notable and sustained leadership pertaining to the Association.

Nominations must:

- Be made in writing.
- Detail the nominee's service and contribution to the Australian oil and gas industry consistent with the eligibility criteria.
- Provide the names of three prominent members of the industry who support the nomination and are prepared to act as referees for the nominee, including at least one APPEA Board Member.

If awarded, the Medal will be presented at the 2023 APPEA Conference in May 2023.
